JOB TITLE:

Golden Coast Beach Volleyball Club (GCBVC) Assistant Coach.

ESTIMATED TIME COMMITMENT:

Time commitment could vary depending on availability but could range from as little as 1.5-2 hours a week to a multitude of that if the desire exists. Dates where the need for assistant coaches would be highest are during June, July and August.

JOB DESCRIPTION:
