# **JOB TITLE:**

Golden Coast Beach Volleyball Club (GCBVC) Social Events and Awards Coordinator

#### **ESTIMATED TIME COMMITMENT:**

Time commitment will vary throughout the volunteer period but could range from as little as one hour a week to a multitude of that prior to a large event. The volunteer period would run from the start of our spring training block, beginning in late April / early May and end when our fall season is complete, in late October / early November.

#### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

This volunteer position involves coordinating end of season social events for our youth and adult club members. Our major youth event takes place at the conclusuion of the fall block around October or November and would involve booking a space that could cater to the majority of our youth athletes and their parents.

Adult events would be smaller and less formal and take place at the end of each seasonal block of training. There is potential for this job to be shared between two individuals with one taking on events involving our youth club and the other for our adult club members.

### **OBJECTIVE / OUTCOME:**

Increasing the social element to our classes and leagues would strengthen the GCBVC 'family' and add value to what we offer at the GCBVC. Due to enhanced experience within our classes and leagues we anticipate increased participation in our classes and returnee nembers.
